Between August 24 and September 11, 2009, the late transaction (Course Add, Changing Credit Hours, or Changing Grade Mode) fee is \$10.00 per transaction. Beginning Monday, September 14, 2009, the late transaction fee is \$75.00 for Course Add and Changing Credit Hours.

The late transaction fee for Changing Grade Mode remains \$10.

An Enrollment Adjustment Card (Pink Card) is still required for any late transaction after the published deadline dates.

Courses beginning on dates other than those listed, as listed in the *Schedule of Classes* available on LoboWeb, are fully refundable if dropped before 20% of the course has been completed, except for Correspondence Courses (see paragraph below). Do not include partial days when calculating 20% of completion. For example, 20% of an eight day course equals 1.6 days. Refund is calculated only if dropped on or before the first day.

Courses five days or less in duration must be dropped on or before the first day of the course to receive a full refund.

Correspondence Courses are fully refundable if dropped before 9% of the course has been completed. Do not include partial days when calculating 9% of completion.

Tuition and fees for courses dropped after the above deadlines will not be refunded.
