# Standard Class Meeting Times for Summer Main Campus 

In the Summer Session 8-week part of a term, contact time must total 300 minutes per week and translate to 100 minutes on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday; or 150 minutes on Tuesday and Thursday. The following is a model for three contact hour courses:

At least $50 \%$ of a department's in-person sections must be scheduled on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Only the home department (primary instructors offering department) will count toward the department's percentages.

All sections should start at on-pattern times.
A class scheduled one day per week must be paired with a section of similar size on the opposite day of the week. This allows full utilization of classroom instructional space and course availability for students. Example for a 4-week section, Tuesday 8:00 am -1:15 pm should be paired with Thursday 8:00 am -1:15 pm.
